1. Introduction

Wickersley Partnership Trust (WPT) believes that school uniform allows equality and fairness for all, and that it prepares young people for the world of work. Uniform has a positive influence on student behaviour and helps to foster a calm and business-like atmosphere, whilst also eliminating the social stigma of what can be extremely expensive fashion trends.

Following a public consultation in 2023, and working closely with all stakeholders, WPT will implement a standard uniform across all secondary schools from September 2024, with each school retaining its individual school colours and logo.

This policy outlines uniform expectations for all students attending the school. It aims to

- x Set out our approach to requiring uniform that is of reasonable cost and offers the best value for money for our families
- x Explain how we will avoid discrimination in line with our legal duties under the Equality Act 2010
- x Set out clearly our expectations for school uniform

These expectations are clear. All students are expected to wear the correct uniform at all times. WPT is grateful for parental support in matters concerning uniform and hope that it will be worn with pride and a sense of belonging to our school communities

2. Uniform Roles and Responsibilities

Students

Students are expected to wear the correct uniform at all times (other than specified uniform days) while:

- x On school grounds
- x Travelling to and from school
- x At out-of-school events or trips that are organised by the school, or where they are representing school

Students are expected to contact their Head of Key Stage / Head of Year / Teaching Head of Year if they want to request an amendment to the uniform policy in relation to a

Local Governing Body

The Local Governing Body will review this policy and ensure that it:

- x Is appropriate to the school's context
- x Is implemented fairly across school
- x

- x Limiting items with distinctive characteristics to low cost and/or long lasting items
- x Avoiding specific requirements for items pupils could wear on school days, such as coats, bags and shoes
- x Introducing the ability to wear plain black trainers for school, reducing to one the number of pairs of footwear that families are required to purchase
- x Reducing to zero the number of items that are required to be purchased

Uniform Policy

- Black and green PE t-shirt with WSSC logo
- Plain black hooded sweatshirt
- Plain black PE style shorts, or
- Plain black sports bottoms / leggings
- Trainers*

*No pumps, slip-ons, sliders or flip-flops etc)

School Uniform

- Black v-neck polo shirt with green piping to neck line and WSSC logo
- Black cardigan with green piping and WSSC logo
- White button-up shirt
- Plain black tailored trousers, or
- Plain black skirt* or
- Plain black shorts* or
- Plain black leather shoes or plain black leather trainers

*Skirts and shorts must be knee-length
 *Skirts must be worn with a belt and
 *Shorts must be worn with black socks

Acceptable Shoes ✓

- Plain black leather shoes, or
- Plain black leather trainers



Unacceptable Shoes ✗

Any colour, that that.

- Pumps, sliders, slippers, Crocs
- Patent leather or faux leather

Shorts

WICKERSLEY

Acceptable Shorts ✓

- Plain black tailored shorts

Shorts must be knee-length and worn with black socks and usual school shoes.



Unacceptable Shorts ✗

- Shorter than knee-length
- Coloured other than black
- Denim, Polyester, Nylon, Jersey, Cycling, Running, Cargo or Bobble shorts

Acceptable Skirts

- Plain black knee-length skirt

Skirts must be knee-length and worn with black tights or socks and usual school shoes.

Unacceptable Skirts

- Shorter than knee-length
- Coloured or brighter than black
- 'Lycra' tube 'style' style
- Pencil style (if skin tight)
- Tight fitting
